The City of Willard Tree Board met at 6:00 PM on May 8, 2014 at Willard City Hall.

In attendance were Lucille Murray, Rick Stenberg, Duane Parker and Jerome Rader.

Guests present: Gaytha Yates.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

Roll Call

Lucille Murray, Rick Stenberg, Duane Parker and Jerome Rader all present.

Approval of the minutes from the meeting on February 20, 2014.

A motion was made by Jerome Rader with a second by Duane Parker to approve the minutes. The motion carried with a vote of 4-0. Voting aye- J. Rader, D. Parker, L. Murray and R. Stenberg. All aye. Motion carries.

Discussion of the T.R.I.M. Grant.

The Tree Board discussed the grant and gave assistance to Gaytha Yates of the Willard Fire Protection District on the grant application and gave guidance on where and what trees to plant at the new station location. The Tree Board determined that there was not enough time for the City to get the information together to complete the grant process for this year.

Old Business

Lucille Murray stated the the Tree Board had spent 750.00 so far in 2014 on trees and materials. The breakdown is: \$210.30 on a saw, \$58.26 on fertilizer, \$350.00 on trees for Arbor Day and \$75.00 on the membership for the Arbor Day Organization.
